

## Very Important to Keep Receipts

- 1. Retain purchase receipts for all machines:**  
Sewing, Embroidery, Sergers, Presses, Software, & Vacuums.
- 2. Mail registration of purchase immediately:**  
After buying your machine, copy serial number and mail card.
- 3. Warranty void without receipt:**  
Manufacturers ask for original receipt to repair machines.
- 4. Receipt necessary for classroom instruction:**  
You must provide Proof-of-Purchase for classes.
- 5. Action required because of "blackmarket" sales:**  
Non-authorized stores cannot offer warranties.

### Software Classes

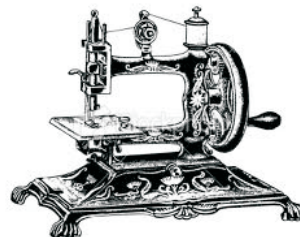
Brother owners learn to combine designs from their embroidery cards and disks, and to download from the Internet.

### Computer Sewing Machine I, II, III Know-How
